

Grinch Panel Quilt

Please read all instructions carefully before you begin!

This pattern is designed for $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seams

Cutting Instructions

- *Start by cutting out all of the panels with $\frac{1}{2}$ " of white around them.**
- There should be 2 small panels and 9 large panels for this quilt
 - The small panels should measure $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " square
 - The large panels should all be $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " tall with varying widths

Dark Green: $5 \frac{1}{4}$ x Full WOF

Green #1: $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $7 \frac{1}{4}$ "

Red # 1 (Grinch Print):

4 - 5 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

2 - $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 6 "

Green Stripe:

1 - 3 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

1 - 3 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

3 - 12 x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

White Print:

4 - 5 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Red/White Stripe:

6 - 3 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Green #2:

3 - 3 " x Full WOF

Green Dot:

1 - 5 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

1 - $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 20 "

Red #2 - Stripe:

4 - 5 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

3 - 3 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Red #3 - Dot:

1 - $8 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

4 - 5 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

1 - $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 6 "

White/Red Dot:

3 - 3 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

4 - 5 " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Green Print:

2 - $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 6 "

Black Fabric: Enough for Bows!

If you're stuck and need help we're available anytime - just call ahead to say you're coming.



For best results, lay out all the pieces you've cut according to the diagram BEFORE you sew!

Construction

1. For this quilt the construction will be done row by row. Refer to the picture above for placement.
2. Row #1: Sew together the Dark Green Strip of fabric with one of the small panel pieces(it should be added to the right side of the strip). Add the small piece of Green #2 fabric to the end of this row.
3. Row #2:
 - a. Sew a Red #1 (5" x 11 ½") piece to either side of a Red/White stripe. Make 2 of these units. They should measure 12" x 11 ½" unfinished.
 - b. To one side of ONE of the units above sew the narrow grinch panel.
 - c. Then to the Grinch panel side, sew a 3" x 11 ½" green stripe unit.

- d. Create a white "present" unit by using 2 pieces of the White print and one Red/White stripe. Make 1 unit that measures 12" x 11 ½" unfinished.
- e. Sew this white present to the green stripe side of the growing row.
- f. To the white present add the Red panel unit.
- g. To finish this row sew the other red unit from Step a.
- h. Sew Row #2 to Row #1.

4. Row #3 (sashing row):

- a. Sew a Green #2 strip to a 3" x 12" Green Stripe
- b. Sew this to Row #2 and trim as needed.

5. Row #4:

- a. Sew a Green dot 5" x 11 ½" strip to the white panel (refer to picture)
- b. Make a present unit with two red #2 Fabrics and one red/white stripe strip. Make 2 units that measure 12" x 11 ½" unfinished.
Set one aside for Row #6.
- c. Sew the unit to the step a. unit.
- d. To the growing row add the tree panel.
- e. Finally add the next four pieces to the row:
 - i. Red #3 - 8 ¾" x 11 ½"
 - ii. White/Red dot - 3" x 11 ½"
 - iii. Red/White Stripe - 3" x 11 ½"
 - iv. Grinch Santa Panel
- f. Sew this row to Row # 3 of the growing quilt.

6. Row #5(sashing row):

- a. Repeat the same steps as Row #3, reverse and sew it to the quilt.

7. Row #6:

- a. Find the present unit that you set aside from Step 5.
- b. Sew the "writing" panel to the above present.
- c. Make a present unit with two White/Red dot fabrics and one Red #2 - stripe strip. Make 2 units that measure 12" x 11 ½" unfinished.
Set one aside for Row #8.
- d. Attach to the row.
- e. Sew the white panel to the growing row.
- f. Make a present unit with two Red # 3 dot fabrics and one White/Red strip. Make 2 units that measure 12" x 11 ½" unfinished. Set one aside for Row #8.
- g. Attach to the row.

8. Row #7(sashing row):

- a. Repeat the same steps as Row #3 and sew it to the quilt.

9. Row #8:

- a. Sew the White dot present and the Red Dot present you have already created together to start Row #8.

If you're stuck and need help we're available anytime - just call ahead to say you're coming.

- b. Sew the next panel on to the row.
 - c. Make a present unit with two White print fabrics and one Red #3 strip. Make 1 unit that measures 12" x 11 ½" unfinished.
 - d. Finish the row by adding the "Meery Grinchmas" panel.
 - e. If your panel is not quite long enough, add a green stripe strip to make up the difference. Cut longer than you need and then trim down after you have sewn Row #8 to the quilt.
10. Row #9:
- a. Sew the 5 small squares and 1 small panel to together in which ever way you would like. Just make sure you are sewing the 5 ¼" sides together, and not the 6" sides.
 - b. Complete the row with the Green dot strip.
 - c. Attach to the quilt and trip the green dot piece as needed.
11. Now it is your chance to use your creativity! Grab a pencil and paper and draw a bow that you like for your presents. Before you cut out the fabric make sure you place your drawing on the quilt to check it shape and size.
- a. Use your preferred method of applique to place the bows on as many of the present units as you would like! (We chose 5).
